China : Possible transport delays

More than 600,000 people were evacuated as tropical storm Fung-wong made landfall on China's southeastern coast.

Shanghai officials closed all ferry stations on Tuesday due to the strong winds, saying they would reopen when conditions improved. Dozens of flights were also cancelled at the province's Fuzhou airport.

In neighbouring Zhejiang, more than 338,000 people were evacuated and more than 27,600 fishing boats ordered back to shore.

Fung-wong, Cantonese for Phoenix, was moving north. It was expected to reach east China's Jiangxi province late Tuesday and remain there for about three days.
