## Dover port strike

The Dover Port Authority (DPA) is reporting that 3 day strike action by port workers is planned from Thursday November 27th. The strike action is a protest as a result of plans to transfer port workers jobs to private companies. The DPA has advised that the port will remain open, as it did during last week's strike, by using non-union staff and outside resources. No delays occurred as a result of the action last week.
