Hurricane Earl

Forecasters are advising that Hurricane Earl, a category 4 storm producing maximum sustained winds of 230 km/h, is heading towards the U.S. East Coast, due to make landfall late Thursday or Friday before curving back out to sea.

The storm is expected to weaken later Thursday, but officials in coastal areas warn of strong winds, heavy rain and large swells. A state of emergency has been declared in North Carolina, Virginia, and Maryland.

Whilst the situation is still developing, GKN Freight Services are predicting some disruption to flights and vessel schedules in and along the U.S. East Coast.
