Icelandic Volcanic Eruption

Drifting ash from an Icelandic volcanic eruption has caused the disruption of flights in and out of Scotland today.

The current weather outlook suggests that there is the possibility of ash reaching other parts of the UK and Ireland later today, however, changing weather patterns make it hard to predict the exact path of the volcanic ash.

At this point, London airports are unaffected, except flights to and from Scotland.
