Incoterms® 2010

Incoterms are a set of three letter abbreviations of standard trading terms, formalising business to business transactions. The recently released revision of these terms, Incoterms 2010, has reduced the original list of thirteen terms down to eleven.

Two new incoterms, DAT and DAP, replace the Incoterms 2000 rules DAF, DES, DEQ and DDU.

DAT – Delivered at terminal (named port of destination)

DAP – Delivered at place (named place of destination)
