## India Port conditions: JNPT/Nhava Sheva

The port of Nhava Sheva (also called Jawaharlal Nehru port) is India's biggest port and handles almost half of the country's maritime traffic.

The port is currently experiencing high volumes of container traffic and vessel arrivals. As of Friday 22nd May 2009 there were nine vessels berthed and being worked upon and a further four vessels waiting to enter the port. There are approximately 3000 containers held on the quayside that are causing serious congestion and delays to Import containers being loaded to the rail network to ICD New Delhi.
