## India's ports resume operations

Following the collision of the MSC Chitra and the MV Khalijia on the 7<sup>th</sup> August, authorities are still trying to locate over 100 containers that are still missing off the coast of Mumbai. The navy is conducting a survey of the sea to try and locate the missing containers, some of which contain hazardous chemicals.

The ports of Mumbai, Nhava Sheva and Jawaharlal Nehru have all resumed operations, although delays are expected for some time due to congestion at the ports and the remaining missing containers.
