## Long delays at Nhava Sheva

Increased container volumes at India's largest port Nhava Sheva are leading to severe delays. There are currently restrictions on moving imported containers from the port to inland terminals, creating long dwell times.

We are currently working with our key customers to secure container "priority rail out" from Nhava Sheva Port to New Delhi ICD.

Delays are also being experienced moving Export containers from common rail heads to the correct terminals. A shortage of pilots is leading to delays in berthing and un-berthing vessels. It is expected that the situation could last for some time.
