Mississippi River

As a result of the recent heavy rains and snow melting in the Midwest, the Mississippi River is flooding. The river reached heights which forced closures on Interstate 40 in Arkansas for 6 days and now concern is being raised about the potential closure of Interstates 20, 10 and 12.

Interstates 10 and 12 are located in Southern Louisiana where the river is not expected to crest until 23.05.11.
