Port Congestion – India

Demonstrations and early monsoon rains are disrupting port operations at JNPT Port in Mumbai (Nhava Sheva) resulting in heavy port congestion. Imports and exports are affected with over 15,000 containers held on the quayside.

The situation is exacerbated by import cargo destined for north India, which cannot be released because there are insufficient trains available to transport containers to destination. This shortage is as a result of protestors blocking railway lines in Jaipur and neighbouring areas. In addition, early monsoon rains have caused waterlogging at the port and along the port access roads.
