Snowfall causes disruption in Spain and U.K.

Heavy snow fell across much of the UK overnight, with southeast and northeast England worst affected. Severe weather warnings are in place for London and the East Midlands.

The snowfall has caused disruption at London airports. Some flights were suspended from London Luton and London City. Flights to Gatwick were being diverted earlier today but the runways have now reopened and Heathrow has been experiencing some delays and cancellations. The snow is also causing disruption on the roads.

In Central Spain heavy snowfall has also caused dangerous driving conditions and transport disruptions.
