Further Update on the Transport Strike in Spain

Yesterday's meeting between the representatives and the Spanish Government was stopped with no agreement reached. Representatives are now having another meeting with the Government, however, it is not expected that the issue will be resolved and the strike is expected to continue.

There have been occasions where small vehicles have crossed the border. This was due to the use of small back roads via Andorra or the Pyrenees mountains. It is clear that strikers are monitoring the situation and that these small back roads will be blocked as well soon.

We are receiving reports that Spanish police are stopping cars and small vehicles on the way to the final delivery point. Police are endeavouring to manage the situation locally to ensure safety in the region.

GKN Freight Services will be doing all possible to endeavour to affect deliveries in these difficult circumstances.

Rail terminals are also being blocked in Spain, so are ports and airports. It was also confirmed by the French rail company (SNCF) that rail transport to or from Spain is not a viable option.
