### Transport protests in France

It is now confirmed that various transport companies in France will be protesting on Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> of June. Other industries, such as taxi companies, affected by rising fuel costs may also join the protest. The intention is not to strike or block the roads, but instead, the plan is to organize "go-slow" operations on key roads in France. This is not due to last longer than a day.

None of GKN Freight Services' hauliers have indicated that they will be on strike on Monday, but delays in transit are inevitable.
