UK Border Agency Strike Action

The UK Border Agency is planning to take strike action from 0700 Monday 8th March through to 0700 on Wednesday 10th March 2010.

Currently, the movement and control of international freight is only subject to the intervention by the UK Border Agency personnel under certain limited conditions where specific border controls are routinely applied.

The National Clearance Hub have advised that they are confident that they will have enough staff resources to provide an acceptable level of service, although there may be short periods of time where the service level targets slip a little. They will prioritise according to customer needs as best as possible.

GKN Freight Services will be closely monitoring the situation but please be advised that some consignments will be subject to delay, clearance wise, because of the strike. We will keep you informed of any further developments, however, in the meantime if you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact us.
