

Driving restrictions, goods transport Denmark

There are no driving restrictions on goods traffic at weekends or on public holidays.

Local driving restrictions

There are, however, local driving restrictions in the centre of Copenhagen for goods vehicles of over 18t MPW. The area concerned is bounded by the following streets: Nørre- and Vester Voldgade, Stormgade, Holmens Kanal and Gothersgade. The route via Chr.IX's Gade - Kr. Bernikowsgade - Bremerholm is authorised.

Furthermore, vehicles of over 3.5t MPW are forbidden to cross Amagertorv and the surrounding pedestrianised streets.

In isolated cases, exemptions may be granted. Application should be made to -

Transport of dangerous goods

The transport of dangerous goods is forbidden in the tunnel section of the Oresund Bridge between 06h00 and 23h00.

Summer driving restrictions

Between 15 June and 31 August, if temperatures reach 25 degrees Celsius and over, a driving ban may be enforced from 12h00 to 18h00 for heavy vehicles transporting abnormal loads.
